

Cost and Scholarship Information

Cost of summer camp will be \$90.00 wkly for day camp. Camp Alexander has a limited number of scholarships available to those who qualify. In order to consider a child for a scholarship, the parent must notify the camp office one month prior to the camp they would like to attend.

Paper work must be filled out to receive the scholarship, if the child receives free or reduced lunches for the '08-'09 school year, then the child may be eligible. Other information may be required. Each request will be reviewed and the amount awarded shall be determined from this information.

Scholarships will be distributed on a first come first serve basis and may run out well before beginning of camp. Please pre-register and pay for your camper to ensure their entrance to camp.
