

Cost and Scholarship Information

Cost of summer camp will be \$85 for day camps and \$150 for residence camps. Camp Alexander has a limited number of scholarships available to those who qualify. In order to consider a child for a scholarship, the parent must notify the camp office one month prior to the camp they would like to attend. Paper work must be filled out to receive the scholarship, if the child receives free or reduced lunches for the '07-'08 school year, then the child may be eligible. Other information may be required. Each request will be reviewed and the amount awarded shall be determined from this information. Scholarships will be distributed on a first come first serve basis and may run out well before the beginning of camps. Please pre-register and pay for your camper to ensure their entrance to camp.

Summer Camp: What's it all about?

The mission of Camp Alexander is to empower children by providing a safe place for growth and enrichment in the great outdoors

Camp enhances self esteem, communication, cooperation, responsibility, leadership, self reliance, and physical fitness by providing children with the opportunities to grow and experience something they would not be able to in any other setting. Each week of camp features a different theme to reach the varying interests of today's youth, but campers will also get to experience traditional camp activities and activities unique to Camp Alexander, such as our *mudslide and milk crate climb*.

Information about Camp Alexander and their staff

Camp Alexander is licensed through the Kansas Department of Health and Environment to run an Outdoor Summer Camp School Age Program and operates to standards set forth by the American Camp Association. Staff undergoes extensive training and screening before working with the children. First Aid, CPR, and Lifeguard certifications are required. We accept children in grades K-8 for all camps. Drop off is 7:30-8:30 and pick up is 4:30-5:30.
